

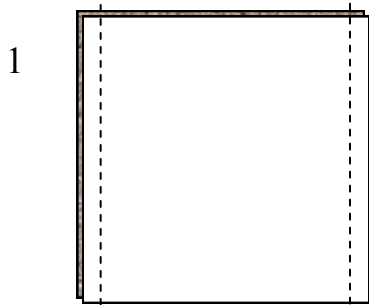

## Block of the Month

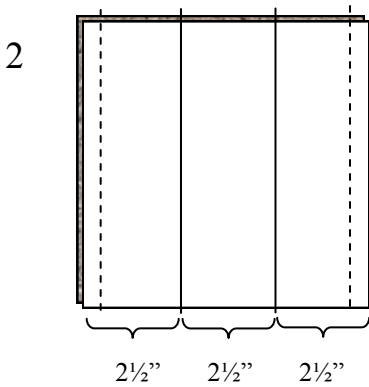
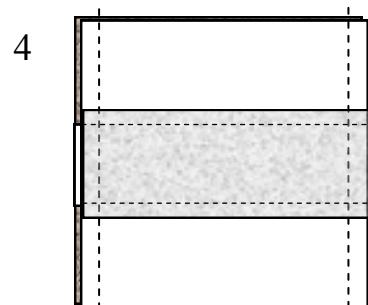
### 2009-2010

#### Row 2—Magic Nine Patch (6")

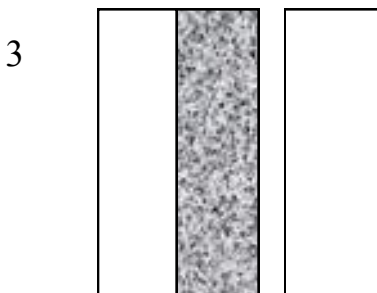
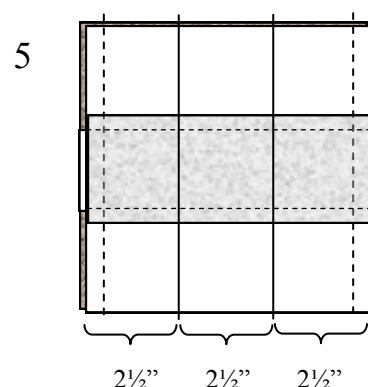
Determine the number of 6" blocks required for your row. (If the number is an odd number, round up.) Cut half that number of 7½" dark squares and the other half of 7½" light squares. Pair up a dark with a light square right sides together and assemble as described below. At stage #3 or #6 you may scramble the units from other blocks for a scrappy look. Don't forget to insert your accent fabric/colour. You can substitute a 7½" square for either a light or dark.



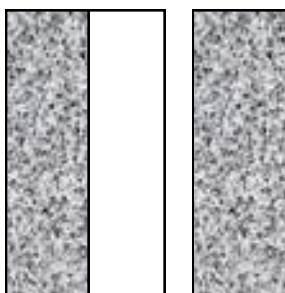
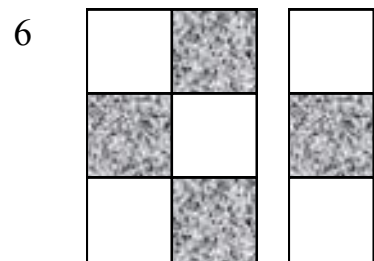
With right sides together, align 7½" squares and sew ¼" seam along opposite sides.



Cut into 2½" sections.



Open out your pieces and add units as shown.



Press seams in to center of one square and out from center in the other.
