Row 5—Appliqué Vine

Refer to the chart on introduction page to determine the width of the quilt you have chosen to make. Prepare an appliqué background piece your quilt width by 10 ½”.

Vine: Cut a bias strip 1 ½” wide and about 1.4 times longer than quilt width. This should give you enough length to make a winding vine across the strip. Fold in half wrong sides together along the length and press. Stitch a scant ¼ inch along the long raw edge. Press seam allowance under using a bias bar. Position on background fabric, as desired, and stitch in place.

Flowers and Leaves: Prepare your appliqué templates and pieces as per your preferred appliqué method. Feel free to make as few or as many flowers and leaves as you wish. Flower layers can be assembled before appliquéing to the background. Stitch in place.
